Dear Mr. Johnson:

This response is submitted in accordance with paragraph 2 of your October 1, 2012 letter which requested as follows:

2. A revised table, pursuant to paragraph 2(a) of the July 26 Order, that includes an updated survey of affordable housing units developed since 2000 in each of the eligible municipalities. The term "affordable" should be defined as for-purchase homes with household income limits no greater than 80 percent of the area median income ("AMI") for Westchester County, and rental homes with household income limits no greater than 60 percent of AMI for Westchester County. The County must provide documentation of all attempts to obtain a survey response from the eligible municipalities.

Enclosed please find the revised "Status of Allocation per Affordable Housing Allocation Plan 2000-2015 – As of November 20, 2012", in response to this request. Please note that the County has also updated the chart to include County Assisted units which have been completed or under construction through November 20, 2012. See Column C. You are advised that on or about October 11, 2012, the County sent a Survey of Affordable Housing to the municipal officials in all thirty-one (31) Eligible Municipalities, requesting a response by November 1, 2012. Copies of all of the e-mails which were sent, along with a sample letter, exhibit and survey that accompanied the request, are enclosed for your review. Fourteen (14) municipalities completed and returned the surveys. Due to the impact and response to Superstorm Sandy, we waited until Monday, November 19, 2012 to send out follow-up e-mails to the remaining seventeen (17) municipalities. Copies of those e-mails are also enclosed for your review. As a result, two (2) municipalities have responded to that request, so only fifteen (15) remain. The relevant information is reflected in the enclosed chart. Finally, a chart showing which municipalities have responded, as well as those who have not, is also enclosed for your review.

Dear Mayor Fixell:

On July 31, 2012, Westchester County provided the enclosed letter and attached table to the court-appointed monitor in relation to the August 10, 2009 Stipulation and Order of Settlement and Dismissal entered into in connection with the lawsuit, *U.S. ex rel. Anti-Discrimination Center of Metro New York v. Westchester County* ("Settlement Agreement"). Column D on the table shows the results of a survey of Westchester municipalities conducted by the County Department of Planning in July 2008. The survey requested each municipality to identify affordable housing units developed since 1990 that did not receive funding assistance from Westchester County. The data is incomplete in that it only reports the results of the six municipalities that responded.

After reviewing this information, the monitor requested that we conduct a new survey of Westchester municipalities in an attempt to obtain more complete data. Therefore, also enclosed with this letter is a new survey form. I would appreciate it if you could designate an appropriate person to review, complete and return this form no later than November 1, 2012.

Again, we seek to identify the total number of housing units that have been created in your municipality that have restrictions on sales price or rent so as to be affordable to those with moderate or lower incomes. Units completed under local inclusionary zoning regulations should be included. As we have complete information on all units that were created with funding assistance from Westchester County, the survey form is limited to non-County funded units.

Attached is Westchester County's response to the directive set out in Paragraph 2(a) of United States District Court Judge Denise L. Cote's July 26 Order in United States ex rel Anti-Discrimination Center of Metro New York, Inc. v. Westchester County, New York (No. 06 civ. 2860 (DLC)) which reads as follows:

a. By August 1, 2012, the County will provide to the Monitor all information in its possession responsive to the Monitor's request that the County state whether each municipality has met its allotted number of affordable housing units under the Westchester County Housing Opportunity Commission Affordable Housing Allocation Plan and identify any shortfall.

The attached chart details the information in the County's possession relating to the Status of Allocation per Affordable Housing Allocation Plan 2000-2015 -- As of December 2011:

Column A is the allocation figure presented in the "Affordable Housing Allocation Plan 2000-2015," dated November 5, 2005, designated as "Table C."

Column B and Column C are total number of affordable units that received funding support from Westchester County during the periods of time described.

Column B is taken from Table C of the "Affordable Housing Allocation Plan 2000-2015," dated November 5, 2005. Column B identifies the total number of affordable units that received funding support from Westchester County during the period January 2000 – July 2005.

Column C identifies the total number of affordable units that received funding support from Westchester County during the period August 2005 – December 2011.

Column D shows the results of a survey of all Westchester municipalities conducted by the County Department of Planning in July 2008. The survey requested that each municipality identify all locally affordable units developed since 1990 that did not receive County funding.

- Most municipalities did not respond to the request so the data is incomplete in that it only reports the results of municipalities that did respond.
- The term "affordable" is subject to interpretation by each municipality. Their definitions may not meet Westchester County's definition of affordability.

Column E shows the difference between the number of units identified in Column A and subtracting the units identified in B, C and D.

A positive number indicates that as of December 2011, based upon the information received to date, much of which is incomplete, and the definitions of which are subject to interpretation by each municipality, the allocation number for that municipality has not been met.

A negative number indicates that as of December 2011, based upon the information received to date, much of which is incomplete, and the definitions of which are subject to interpretation by each municipality, the allocation number for that municipality has been exceeded.
